What is required to be a MnUSA club?

Club provides member information to MnUSA

Club collects MnUSA dues with their membership and sends them to MnUSA office in a timely fashion

Club officers are members of MnUSA

What is the benefit of being a MnUSA club?

Club is listed on MnUSA's website, including club officer page, club event listing in website club calendar, link to website and email to accept inquiries on club membership

Club receives updates from MnUSA

Clubs are eligible to participate in programs developed to aid in trail signing, maintenance, etc.

Clubs may host MnUSA events

MnUSA promotes club activities with our web site and *Minnesota Snowmobiling*

MnUSA provides membership incentives to grow your club and increase members

MnUSA coordinates local and statewide lobbying by our full time professional lobbyist

MnUSA informs and educates members on state, federal, and international snowmobile issues

MnUSA works for increases and protection in grant in aid and trail funding programs

MnUSA can assist with becoming a club, incorporate, obtain permits, or other legal documentation

Trail liability insurance can be purchased under MnUSA's policy

MnUSA provides Board of Directors to assist clubs within the state

MnUSA provides an exchange of snowmobile information and snowmobile camaraderie throughout the state

MnUSA's office staff supports all levels of snowmobiling and is a source for safety information, posters, decals, variety of snowmobile related brochures, statistics, and facts

MnUSA is the communications link between the snowmobiler, the snowmobile dealers and snowmobile manufacturers

MnUSA provides communication between the snowmobile community and Department of Natural Resources, Explore Minnesota Tourism, state legislative leaders, other recreational users, and state, national and international snowmobile associations

Each club/MnUSA member receives:

Official MnUSA membership card and decal

Annual trail guide – *Destinations* magazine

Discounts at participating business members throughout Minnesota and the US

Subscription to *Minnesota Snowmobiling* magazine – eight issues per year

\$3500 accidental death/dismemberment insurance for member, spouse and children under 18 years of age

Minnesota Snowmobiling Rider Assist Directory (MNSNOWRAD) for when you need assistance on the trail, road, or planning a ride.

A \$5 discount on MnUSA membership. Dues are \$20 per year when sent in on a club roster or \$25 for an individual/family membership not paid through a club.
